As most are aware, the Historic Millwork District in Dubuque is undergoing a major transformation, starting with Complete Streets. Complete Streets are designed and operated to enable safe access for all users. Pedestrians, bicyclists, motorists, and public transportation users of all ages and abilities are able to safely move along and across a complete street. Complete Streets make it easy to cross the street, walk to shops, and bicycle to work.

The project includes complete utility upgrades, street reconstruction, permeable pavers to help alleviate storm water problems, enhanced historic lighting, seating, and other streetscape amenities.

Below is the current construction schedule for the Historic Millwork District Complete Streets Project. This is a useful tool for downtown stakeholders who may be affected by these street upgrades.
